

21 WAYS TO SHARE THE GOSPEL IN 2021

The Cedar Crest mission to “Make disciples of Jesus Christ in the Lehigh Valley” is an important part of being a child of God. Begin by **Praying Fervently** that God would provide opportunities to share the Gospel.



1. Share with a friend, neighbor, or co-worker what you are learning in your devotions.
2. Use your testimony and experiences as ways to open the door to share the Gospel.
3. Hand write or type a thoughtful letter to a friend, family member, or neighbor and include a brief Gospel message. Also ask of ways you can be praying for them. Include your phone number in the letter and let them know you are always available to talk.
4. Watch a respectable Christian movie with a friend or neighbor and have a conversation about it (i.e. “Case for Christ, American Gospel: Christ Alone”).
5. Have a Backyard Bible Club at your house and invite families from your neighborhood to join. The Local Outreach Team will help you plan this neighborhood initiative.
6. Invite international friends to a Christian open wedding ceremony where they would hear the Gospel. Talk to them afterward about the biblical meaning of marriage.
7. Invite your neighbors over for a meal especially over the holidays when you can use the opportunity to explain the true reason for celebrating.
8. Instead of eating lunch alone at work or school, eat with other co-workers or classmates to hear their story and share about the gospel from your own life story.

9. Create opportunities to share the gospel before or after the work day by starting a walking/exercise group or even a carpool for co-workers in your area.
10. Visit co-workers or other classmates while they are in the hospital, and use the opportunity to pray with them and talk about the Savior who came to defeat our sin and conquer all suffering and death.
11. Go out of your way to talk about the gospel with some overlooked people in your life, such as maybe janitors in your workplace or unpopular kids at your school.
12. Use “What did you do over the weekend?”, and then share about church on Sunday.
13. Ask your waiter/waitress if you can pray for them just before you give thanks at a restaurant. Follow up with them after your meal and offer a Gospel tract.
14. Street evangelism! Join the Cedar Crest team.
15. Give a Gospel tract to the cashier at the grocery store when you're checking out and ask how you can be praying for them.
16. Share the hope of the Gospel on social media.
17. Keep Gospel tracts outside your front door for people to freely take.
18. Be prepared to share the Gospel with Jehovah's Witnesses.
19. Lawn signs and vehicle signs.
20. Your phone. Share the gospel on your voicemail greeting, witness to telemarketers when they call you, or text back strangers with the gospel message.
21. Invest in an outreach ministry here at **Cedar Crest** to form relationships for the purpose of sharing Christ.
