DATE	QUESTION	ANSWER
4/2	<b>Question 22</b> Why must the redeemer be truly human?	That in human nature he might on our behalf perfectly obey the whole law and suffer the punishment for human sin.
4/9	<b>Question 23</b> Why must the redeemer be truly God?	That because of his divine nature his obedience and suffering would be perfect and effective.
4/16	<b>Question 24</b> Why was it necessary for Christ, the Redeemer, to die?	Christ died willingly in our place to deliver us from the power and penalty for our sin, God will remember our sins no more.
4/23	<b>Question 25</b> Does Christ's death mean all our sins can be forgiven?	Yes, because Christ's death on the cross fully paid the penalty for our sin, God will remember our sins no more.
4/30	<b>Question 26</b> What else does Christ's death redeem?	Every part of fallen creation
