



DROP OFF

Due to limited parking and a high number of registrations, we are using a staggered procedure for check-in for this weekend. This is so that you and your camper have the quickest and easiest check-in procedure as possible, so that they can get to the fun!

In order to allow for the easiest parking process, we are asking that if your camper's last name starts with A-M, please arrive between 7:00 PM and 7:30 PM. If your camper's last name starts with N-Z, please arrive between 7:30 and 8:00 PM.

Check-in is in Victory Hall (The gym in the main building on your right as you drive into camp). You will be directed to park by the Pavilion. If you are bringing a group of campers from your church, please be sure to sign in all of them when you arrive. After checking in, you can help your camper settle into their assigned cabin and meet their counselors.

PICK UP

Pickup is at 1:00 PM in Victory Hall on Sunday.

You will be directed to park by the Pavilion. From there you can come to the Gym to sign your camper(s) out, and their counselor will retrieve the camper and luggage to send them home after a weekend of fun! Remember, you must sign out the camper before you can collect them and their belongings.

WHAT TO BRING

Remember, whether there is snow or not, as long as it is not raining we plan on spending time out in God's Creation by participating in activities and spending some free time outside. Please be sure your camper is dressed and prepared to be out in the cold, and check the weather to prepare for potential snow or low temperatures.

Remember that medications need to be in their original packaging or in a prescription bottle with the instructions provided. Please do not bring any more than is necessary for your child for the weekend.

AGE DIFFERENCES

Winter Blast (7-11 y/o)

- a. The curriculum and program for Winter Blast, while meant for all ages in this range, is geared younger than usual, as the majority of campers are 8-10 years old. This means the requirements are different than for summer.
- b. Older campers who are outside the age range may attend if their birthday is during the current calendar year, meaning January 1 through the first day of their session, and their grade is the same as their peers.
- c. 7-year old campers may attend if they will be turning eight before the end of the summer season, and their grade is the same as their peers. Our counselors are trained to work with younger campers, but being overnight for the first time can be intimidating, and it presents challenges for both staff and other campers if a young camper is struggling to adjust.
