## ENCOURAGEMENT

## FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS

- **Familiarize yourself with CDC Guidelines**
- **Do your best to practice social distancing**
- **If you are sick or have come into contact with someone who has COVID-19, please stay home.**
- **You must turn in a signed permission slip the first time you attend this Summer**
- **Everyone must wear a mask while indoors**
- **Water fountains will not be accessible, so please bring your own water bottles and do not share**
- **Disinfectant wipes will be in bathrooms (please wipe down surfaces after use)**
- **Hand sanitizer stations will be accessible in each area**
- **Most importantly, please bring your own Bibles! We will not be handing out any Bibles.**
- **Feel no guilt if you choose to stay home because you or your parents do not feel safe**

## ARRIVAL – 6 pm

- **WHERE?** - Chapel Entrance
- **PERMISSION SLIP** – Please bring your signed permission slip the first week you attend
- **ATTENDANCE:** Please check in with those taking attendance in foyer (\*this is in case someone from the group tests positive for COVID-19 we can contact everyone)

## GAMES – 6 pm

- **TWO OPTIONS**
  - **Field & Parking Lot**
    - We **encourage** students to be **outside** weather permitting. Please bring your favorite backyard games (i.e. cornhole, kanjam, polish, frisbee, etc.) **\*Masks are NOT required outside**
  - **Chapel & Fellowship Hall**
    - Students may bring boardgames, cards, and we can set up a computer for students to play “Kahoot!” (trivia with their phones)
    - We will limit the amount of people per room to **25**
    - **\*Masks are required**
- **\*ALL STUDENTS AND LEADERS MUST SANITIZE HANDS AFTER GAME TIME\***

## SINGING

- **WHERE?** – The Activity Center (GYM)
- **SEATING** – Students and Leaders will be spread out with no more than 4 students in a row (chairs will not be touching)
- **MASKS** – **\*Masks are required**

## TEACHING

- **WHERE?** – The Activity Center (GYM)
- **SEATING** – See Singing Section Above
- **MASKS** – **\*Masks are required**
- **\*All messages will be recorded and available on our podcast “Cedar Crest Youth Group” the next day on major podcast hosts**

## SMALL GROUPS

- **WHERE?** – In the same classrooms as before!
- **SEATING** – Students will be asked to spread out during small group time
- **MASKS** – **\*Masks are required if you choose to sit closer than 10 ft apart and you meet inside. Masks are optional if your group chooses to go outside**

## PICK UP – 8 pm

- **WHERE?** – Chapel Entrance
- **TIMING** – Please do not stay inside after small group ends (unless there is poor weather). Please head home as soon as possible
- **HAND SANITIZING** – Please utilize one of our hand sanitizing stations before heading home
